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Most flights, both together international along with national, get to the Henri Coanda Air-port , found in Otopeni, 19 kilometers to the north of area down-town. Henri Coanda air port generally referred to as Otopeni regarding airline flight reservations, because of the place at Otopeni. The air-port, constructed in 1968, underwent a substantial modernization work since the late 90's and it's arranged to get much more enlarged. It is the most important hub for the Romanian company Tarom and its used by the major global airlines. Practically all snack bars included in the terminal transfer (vendors, cafes, dining places) are extremely overpriced (all things are about twice costly in comparison with the town). Avoid exchanging money in the terminal transfer, exchange rates tend to be 20-25% poorer compared to what you will find in the town - you are advised to use a debit card at an Cash machine inside the lobby for immediate requirements and trade your money in town. There's a shop on the bottom floor (internal departure) and that is a reasonable spot to have a snack and/or spend the your last couple Lei upon leaving.

The smaller Aurel Vlaicu Air-port was used for private flights since 1920s; this present building was executed in 1952 built using a 1930s layout. It actually is proudly located inside the capital, inside Baneasa, around 4-6 kilometers at the town heart and it is utilised for the most part by business enterprise, charter as well as low-cost flight companies: BlueAir , WizzAir , Germanwings .

Be aware that this airport terminal is in fact amazingly modest (just 3 gates), together with out of date features and is getting very crowded especially in the charter period (June-September and December), made to work with a tenth of guests it actually covers. All the runway and also taxiways were totally improved in '07, as well as a completely new airport terminal structure is under construction. Free of charge WI-fi is available (if you're able find a place to sit down and power-up the laptop computer, which is no small task). There is an ATM in the departures hallway near the Blueair check in however it's not always operating. The exchange desk gives you terrible exchange rates. Having said that, if you walk out of terminal and turn left (to the city center) you can find several ATM's couple of blocks down the street. You can purchase public transport tickets from a desk around the bus stop on the opposite side of the avenue that goes outside the airport.

In addition, a good deal of [Hotel Bucuresti](#) can be spotted in the neighborhood, which accommodate all your needs, this lodgings, hotels range from low-priced 2 stars rooms to 5 stars high class [Hotel Ieftin Bucuresti](#), the cost being very good and having most the services. Restaurants and also Shopping Mall happen to be found a few Min's driving out of the air-port, soo everyone can have a walk around if the flight is overdue.

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
