Forth on our list of new wonders is located in Rio de Janiero, Brazil. The Art Deco statue of Christ the Redeemer towers 130 feet height and 100 feet wide and looks down on the city of Rio. It is located at the top of Mount Corcovado which reaches a height of 2,300 feet. This statue of Christ is known to be the largest Art Deco statue in the world.

Mount Everest is the fifth wonder. If you are traveling with your family, you will want to gaze at it from the summit but avid mountain climbers make it a lifetime dream to scale the slopes of Mount Everest. It is known to be the highest place on the face of the earth with its peakreaching 29,002 feet into the heavens.

The sixth Wonder of the World is more of an occurrence than an actual place. It is the Aurora or what is sometimes called the Northern Lights. While it is seen best from far northern latitudes in Canada and other extremely northern countries, to see these lights dancing in the sky is a sight never to be forgotten.

The final wonder of the world is Paricitun, a volcano in Mexico. Surrounding this volcano is the lava-covered town of MichoacÃ¡n, Mexico.
