If you travel farther north to Alta, Norway, you can experience perhaps the oldest prehistoric rock art available for viewing on the face of the earth. These carvings are believed to date back to 4200 BC and detail what life was like for our very first relatives. Over 5000 pieces of this ancient art can be found in Europe providing a rare opportunity to see a pictorial diary of prehistoric man.
