# Travel To New Yorks JFK From Manchester

The US company American Airlines has now started a new service to JFK, New York, from Manchester Airport. The service started running on May 16<sup>th</sup> and will keep running up until September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2010.

If youre trying to cut down the price of your flights, have a look at last minute deals online, as you can usually save yourself some money on your tickets. As far as [airport parking](#) goes, try and spend a decent amount of time searching on the internet. Be sure to search for the airport youre after and click on more than just the first one or two links, have a proper look around as it gives you a greater chance of finding a suitable deal. You should be able to find and compare lots of companies offering to supply you with long or short-term parking, allowing you to pick the best quote and save yourself a considerable sum of money.

You should also employ a similar tactic with your currency exchanges - dont just exchange them at the airport because its convenient. Keep hold of them and shop around, youll almost certainly be able to find a higher exchange rate somewhere else if youre just willing to put the time in researching. The Post Office, and sometimes banks, will often offer exchanges on foreign currency with no comission, although you may have to prove you have an account with them first.
